VINEYARD LOCATION	Uco Valley, Mendoza.
VINES PER HECTARE	5.500 (high density)
HEIGHT OF THE VINEYARD	1.050 mts. above sea level.
SOIL	Limestone, alluvial origin with gravel in the subsoil, originating from a very rocky soil.
CLIMATE	Continental with low average rainfall (200 mm. per year)
HARVEST	Manual, in 18 Kg plastic bins.
TASTING NOTES	Bright deep red color with violet hues. The nose offers notes of red fruits, vanilla, with elegant and well integrated wood. The palate has a soft and sweet attack, a nice volume in mouth with ripe and silky tannins. Harmony and balance best define this wine.
